They completed the B-grade season unbeaten by trouncing Waiouru 8-1 in the final round at Hawkestone on Sunday.

It was close to a similar smoking when Feilding thumped Marton 11 1/2- 1/2. Marton's only half point came when 7-handicapper Troy Calkin halved with 2.2 handicapper Brad Sinclair.

Palmerston North had to battle to beat Wanganui 7-5, coming down to the final two matches. Palmerston North won the foursomes 2 1/2-1 1/2 and the singles 4 1/2-3 1/2.

The host team won the top three singles, Mike McSherry beat Rick Harding 4 and 3, Regan Cording beating Michael Arnott 4 and 3 and Rhys Harold downing Stu Gillespie 2 and 1.

Levin beat neighbours Foxton 7 1/2-4 1/2. Foxton did well at the top with Junior Tatana beating Kim Ballantyne 2 and 1, Lance Knowles downing Shaun Millard 3 and 2 and Jason Tatana beating Reuben Tomane 5 and 4.
